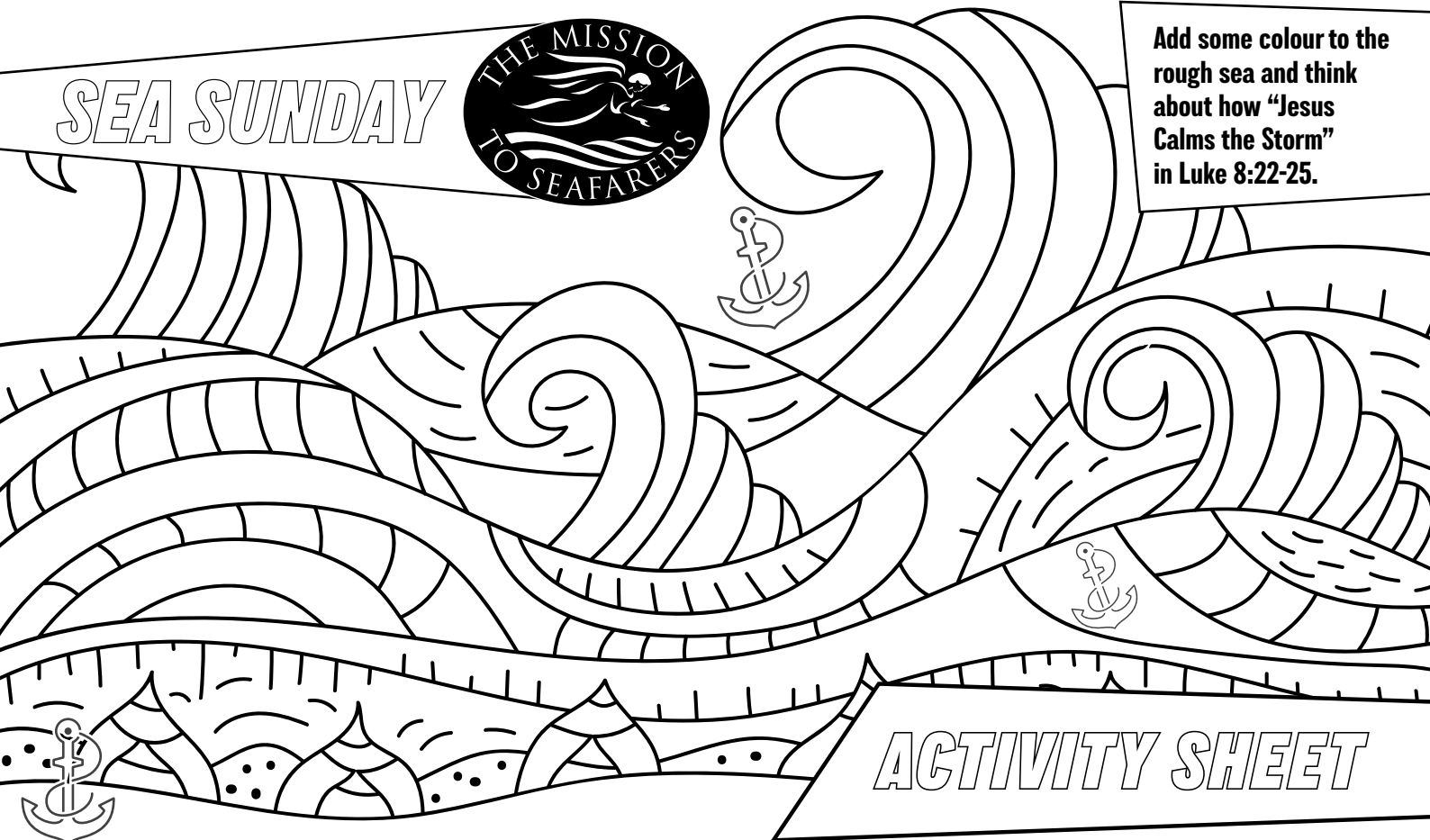


# SEA SUNDAY

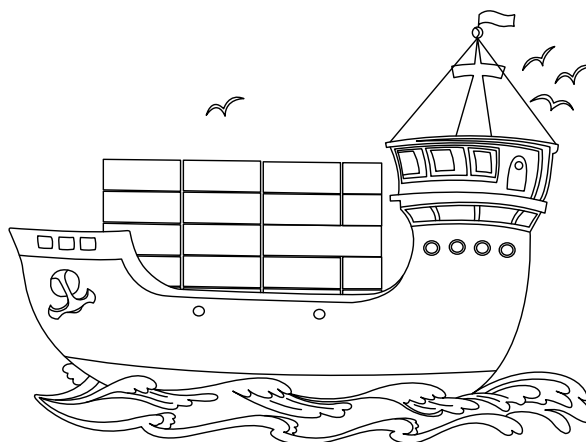
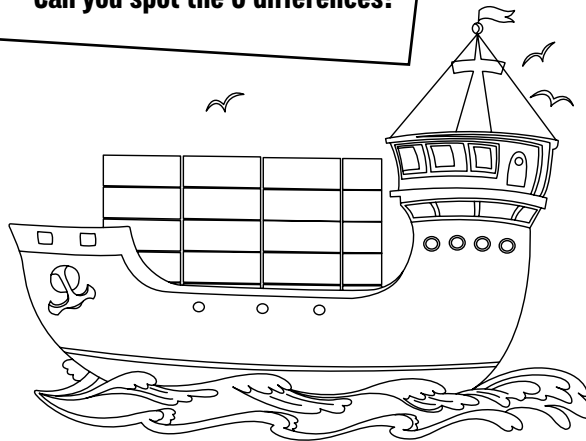

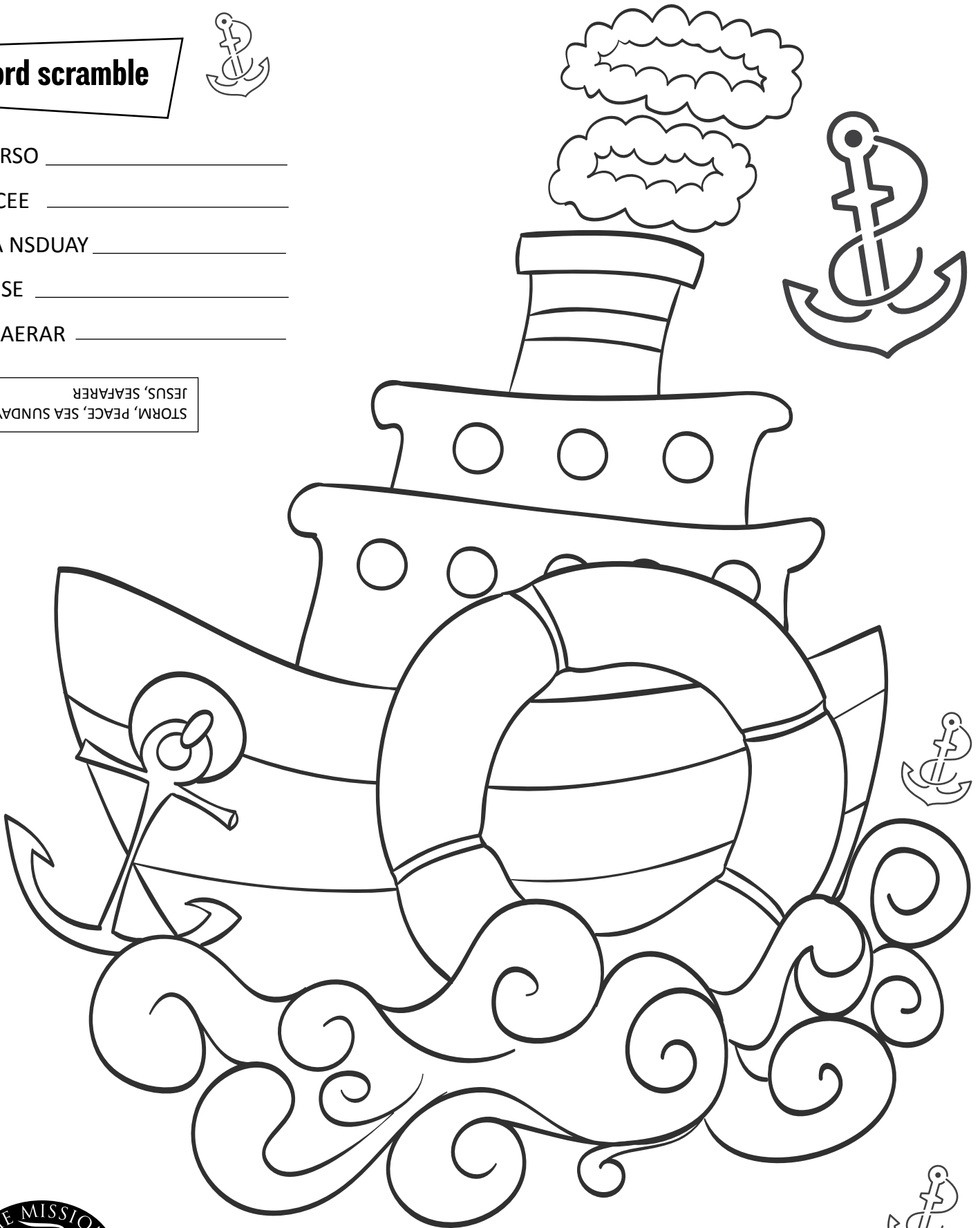
